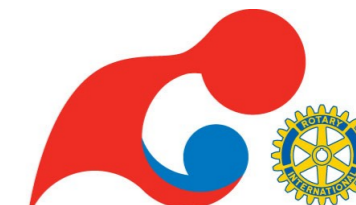
## Today's Program
