Break Bread Together

"Break Bread Together", a local mealson-wheels type program sponsored by the 1st Presbyterian Church of Valdosta began on December 3, 1973. It is a volunteer community service project that furnishes a hot, balanced, noonday meal five days a week all year long to approximately 50 low income, usually elderly, homebound recipients in Valdosta with no one in the home to care for them.

Each Month 80+ caring volunteers from all walks of life and all age groups are involved in serving in this program as deliverers, sorters, callers, and supporters in numerous other ways. The project is funded by churches, social/service clubs, and interested individuals.
