#### **Proposed New Members**

#### **Proposed Amendment**

The Board addressed a proposed amendment to the Bylaws carried over from Richard Barnes' presidency concerning payment for meals by senior active members. The amendment was voted down unanimously. It will continue to be considered on a case-by-case basis.

#### **District Raffle**

To encourage participation in the district raffle, the Board approved an **OPT-IN** proposal. Secretary Barbara Knight has prepared a form which is on the table.
