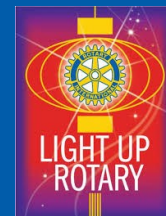

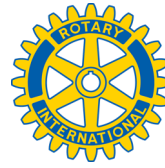
Jessica Bolesta

Last week Jessica Bolesta, founder of Raisin' Cane, shared with us the significant role family farms play in Georgia. She stressed the importance of purchasing American produce and of supporting local farmers.

When she asked how many of our members have been to a farm, most acknowledged that they have visited farms and have family members who own farms, but few of us have had the experience of working on one and fewer still have helped on a family farm.

As a fifth-generation member of the local family-owned farm enterprise, she talked about how being actively involved in farming

from the time she was a child shaped her love of working the land. Her family "planted the seeds" in their children that grew their farm and produce market into a successful agri-tourism business. Today Raisin' Cane visitors can experience agriculture by touring a real working farm and learning how food is grown. Everyone in the family can have fun in the corn maze and enjoy other interactive attractions. They can purchase home-grown goods, dine on fresh-from-the-farm home-cooked meals from Kim's Kitchen, and enjoy tasty treats from the bakery.
